

I give all praise to the father of our Lord and Saviour for allowing me this privilege to be present at College Street at this time of the Church's transition .

2nd Peter 3:18 encourages: 'But grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.' I believe that Bishop Allen and all who are involve in the leading and implementation of this program have had the conviction about what is needed for the Church's growth at this time and was inspired to follow the leading of Lord with this approach.

What I like about this strategy is that everyone, from the youngest to the oldest can connect with it within and through all of our ministries and at a time that is most convenient to us. The topics are also very relevant for all of

us. It is so very important that we understand what we believe for growth in our discipleship and our confidence to defend the faith - for example what we mean by salvation and sanctification and how we explain them to others with clarity and conviction. I also like the fact that we are all learning together and making the transition together. Some may be quicker than others but we will all get to the place of excellence in our mutual commitment to the service of the Lord. I also like the fact that we are using our Declarations of Faith to augment what we are preaching ,teaching and learning.

I celebrate some changes I observe to date and consider to be markers of growth in discipleship:

- The level of interest and commitment in the effort to become more matured in the faith
- The increasing number of people who are actively engaged in the program
- Conversations about greater knowledge and deeper understanding about the different topics we have been covering
- A willingness amongst our members to articulate more freely about the changes that have taken place in their lives

I praise the Lord that we are embracing this program with the expectations that it will cause a richer spiritual experience and outcome for the benefit of all of us as believers, as well as our impact on the visitors who come to our church, our families and the wider community.

I have also noticed the impact of this strategy on our worship team. I believe they reflect the positive paradigm shift we hoped for and are leading us in a much more focussed and inspiring worship experience through the hymns and choruses they select to reinforce the message of the monthly themes of the programme. The Adult Sunday School is another point of reference for me in terms of a positive change. I think the teaching and learning have become more practical and engaging.

I encourage every member and visitor to engage with this program if you are not already doing so. Try and answer the following three questions in your effort to grow as a disciple of Jesus:

What do we need to know (our beliefs)? How do we need to be (our attitudes)? What do we need to do (our behaviours)?



Be reminded to keep a note of your answers. As suggested, you might even go one step further and make use of a dedicated notebook to record questions, such as the ones above, and your answers as well as your growth/personal development plan throughout this learning process.




