
As we prepare to open our church doors again please join us for 21 days of prayer.





The enforced 'Lockdown' has brought about a 'New normal' which none of us would ever even slightly imagine 5 months ago. Society and life in general including Church worship has changed

dramatically.

On March 26, 2020 I was advised by GP to selfisolate for 12 weeks to which I reluctantly complied. Thankfully. our local Church leadership has considered some new ways of ministry to address the demands of the challenges and has utilised some innovative ways for 'being and doing Church without walls'. Since Sunday 22 March 2020, until this current COVID-19 situation ends, the Church services are delivered online. In my opinion, this has positively impacted many of us. We have moved closer to God. We have been challenged to address the constraints of the 'Church walls' and give more thoughts as to how we might minister more effectively to those beyond our four walls. We have become more aware of how much we need the support of each other and how we could better support one another. I have been introduced to new a technology called "ZOOM".

Since April, we have been privileged to engage in a round -table Bible Study called "Theological Reflections" via ZOOM meetings on Wednesday evenings. Each week we have a different topic, related to our overall 'Living what we believe'.

I find that the weekly topics are planned to fit perfectly well with what we hear and read in the media and relate well to how I generally feel about the issues they raise for me. After the sessions, I usually reflect on the scriptures read

and discussed. This provides me with considered biblical reference and guidance for this 'unprecedented' time of uncertainties.

I realise that life for the best of believers are full of certainties. Nations blame one another for the problems we face. The conspiracy theories, along with the doomsday speculators are throwing their hats into the ring, so to speak and folks are becoming restless and apprehensive. With all the negative news that we have to contend with, if we are not diligent, we will easily stray from God and His word and lose balance. Like everyone else, as Christians, we too are desperately, vehemently. and passionately searching for answers to the questions such challenges bring to the surface.

I have an online TROLLS and I am alarmed by how the general public blame and pour scorn on Christians all over my social media pages, so much that sometimes I even question my own faith. This is when I give God thanks for our online Church activities. Not just the Wednesday evening Theological Reflection but the virtual Sunday services the daily devotionals and the Thursday evening Men's ZOOM meetings.

Speaking for myself, the Church fellowship along with the digital services keep me level headed. There is always a Scripture from our Theoretical Reflection meetings or one of the other digital meetings that I can use as a source of daily empowerment.
